John played the role of Bones in an episode of "Mataku", before his breakout role in the hit children's television series, "Power Rangers S.P.D." as Commander Anubis 'Doggie' Cruger, the S.P.D. Shadow Ranger. This was a notable role for John, as he was the only actor in the series to play both the voice actor and the suit actor of Doggie Cruger. In the next season of Power Rangers, "Power Rangers Mystic Force", John returned to the franchise to play Daggeron, the Solaris Knight. John is the only actor to portray the role of two different mentors that were also Power Rangers.

Since then, John's career only went up, as he was offered the role of Bolg in the beloved film franchise "The Hobbit: The Battle of Five Armies," to which he also played the suit actor for, giving much credit to his experience as Doggie Cruger on Power Rangers S.P.D. John has also been a part of other large film franchises, such as the character Korso in "Solo: A Star Wars Story" and Kal Hobbs in "Fast & Furious Presents: Hobbs & Shaw." John portrayed the character of real life wrestler Afa Anoa'i, one of two members of the professional wrestling duo, The Wild Samoans, in the 2021 television series, "Young Rock", telling the story of Dwayne 'The Rock' Johnson's youth and being raised around his professional wrestling family. John was most recently cast as the voice actor for Mauga in the upcoming game, "Overwatch 2".

When he's not filming, John enjoys spending time with his wife, Liyah, and their four children.

Shaun Herman Weiss is an American actor, and stand-up comedian known for his roles in “The Mighty Ducks” franchise, as well as the 1995 Disney film “Heavyweights”.

Weiss started his acting career as Elvis on “Pee-wee’s Playhouse”, but his breakout role came when he earned the part of Greg Goldberg in “The Mighty Ducks” films. Weiss was originally supposed to play Atuk the Eskimo in the first Mighty Ducks film and had one line, but his role was expanded. After the first two Mighty Ducks movies, he appeared as Josh Birnbaum in the Disney film “Heavyweights.” He also appeared in a recurring role as peripheral freak ‘Sean’ on NBC’s “Freaks and Geeks”, as well as cameo appearances on “The King of Queens.”

He appeared in commercials for Captain Morgan, Castrol, Verizon Communications, and Mobile ESPN. Weiss appeared in the movie “Drillbit Taylor”, making an appearance as the school bus driver around the beginning of the film.

In 2022, Shaun appeared in the film “Jesus Revolution”, his first film in 14 years.

# RJ MITTE

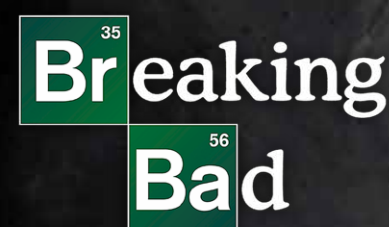
ACTOR



After receiving several roles as an extra, including in the Disney series Hannah Montana. Mitte became interested in films and decided to take acting lessons. Shortly after, he was offered the role of Walter White Jr., a character who also has cerebral palsy, in the AMC series "Breaking Bad." At the 2013 Media Access Awards, Mitte received the SAG-AFTRA Harold Russell Award for his portrayal of Walter White Jr. on the series and also presented the eponymous RJ Mitte Diversity Award to deaf actor Ryan Lane. The Screen Actors Guild named Mitte as the spokesman for actors with disabilities and he is the representative of Inclusion in the Arts and Media of Performers with Disabilities, which employs artists with disabilities.

He starred in the short horror film Stump in 2011. That same year, he worked as executive producer of the documentary Vanished: The Tara Calico Story, about the disappearance of Tara Calico. Mitte was cast in the 2012 thriller film House of Last Things.

Mitte appeared in the 2013 music video for "Dead Bite" by rapcore band Hollywood Undead. He also appeared in the video for "If I Get High" by Nothing But Thieves in 2016. In January 2014, he began a recurring role on the ABC Family drama series Switched at Birth portraying Campbell, a premed student paralyzed from a snowboarding accident who uses a wheelchair.

# ERNIE REYES JR.

Ernie Reyes Jr. (born January 15, 1972) is an American actor, stunt performer and martial artist.

Reyes made his film debut at age 13 in the 1985 film "The Last Dragon". The same year he shared the screen with Arnold Schwarzenegger and Brigitte Nielsen in "Red Sonja". During this time, he also had his own television series, "Sidekicks", a spin-off of the original Walt Disney one-time special "The Last Electric Knight", alongside Gil Gerard presented by Michael Eisner. He also appeared in an episode of the hit television series "MacGyver" in 1988.

Reyes had starring roles in "Surf Ninjas" as Johnny, and "Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles II: The Secret of the Ooze" as Keno, the pizza delivery boy. He also served as the martial arts stunt double for Donatello in the first "Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles" film. He later appeared in films such as "Rush Hour 2" playing Zing, and in "The Rundown" alongside WWE wrestler Dwayne 'The Rock' Johnson. Reyes guest starred in three episodes of the TV series "Kung Fu: The Legend Continues" alongside David Carradine.

Reyes has done motion capture stunts for blockbuster films such as "Avatar" and "Alice in Wonderland". He also played a cemetery warrior in "Indiana Jones and the Kingdom of the Crystal Skull", who gets killed by his own poison dart. Reyes guest starred on NCIS: Los Angeles "The Frozen Lake" playing Jay Thapa, a Nepalese soldier who is an expert in knife-fighting.

Walter Emanuel Jones (born November 30, 1970) is an American actor, martial artist, singer and dancer, known for playing the role of Zack Taylor, the original Black Ranger on the hit television series "Mighty Morphin Power Rangers". Walter is also well known for his role as Harlan Band in the hit Nickelodeon series "Space Cases", as well as Boomer in the Disney Channel original movie, "Brink!"

Walter also appeared in successful television shows including "Family Matters", "Step by Step", "Sabrina, the Teenage Witch", "Moesha", "Buffy the Vampire Slayer", "Early Edition", "NYPD Blue", "CSI: Crime Scene Investigation", "Off Centre" and "The Shield". He played in films including "Backyard Dogs (2000)", "House of the Dead 2 (2005)", "Popstar: Never Stop Never Stopping (2016)" and "House Party (2023)". He gave his voice talent to animated films including "Open Season 2 (2008)" and "Cloudy with a Chance of Meatballs 2 (2013)". In 2021, he starred in the 7th episode of the second season of the series "Boomerang". The same year, he acted in the dramatic film "Memoirs of a Fighter" alongside Eric Roberts and Tara Reid. In 2023, Walter appeared briefly in the video on demand film, "House Party". He also reprised his role as Zack Taylor, the Black Ranger in the 30th anniversary special of Power Rangers, titled, "Mighty Morphin Power Rangers: Once & Always".

On June 11, 2023, he released his debut single "Dance" under the stage name "Tre Emanuel" to widespread fan acclaim.



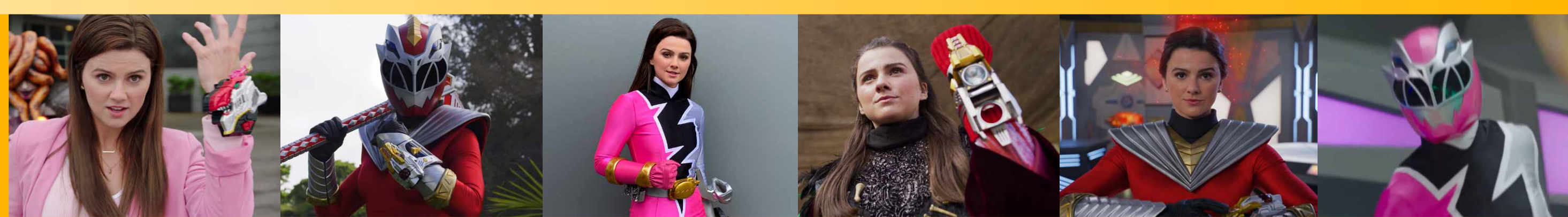
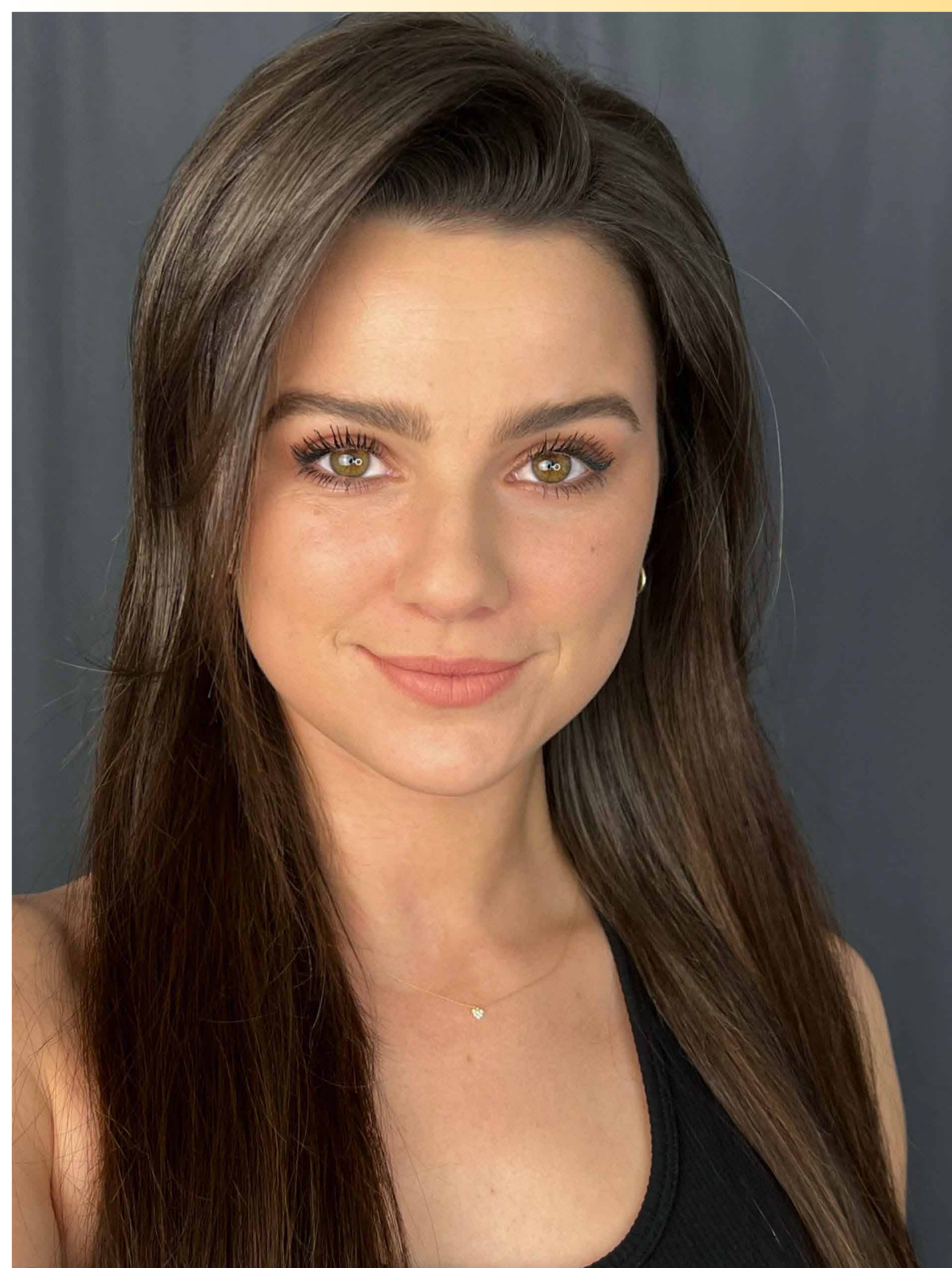

With an illustrious career spanning 45 years, Lar Park Lincoln has etched an enduring legacy in film, television, and live performances. Beyond being a seasoned actress, she is the founder and CEO of Actors Audition Studios, headquartered in Dallas, Texas.

Lar made her acting debut when she secured the lead role in the 1985 film for television, "Children of the Night." Her contribution to television continued in 1987 with her memorable five-year portrayal of dual characters on "Knots Landing." Also in 1987, she appeared in the comedy horror "House II: The Second Story" and following year starred as Tina Shepard in the slasher film, "Friday the 13th Part VII: The New Blood", the seventh installment in the Friday the 13th franchise. She also guest-starred on television series including "Hunter", "Outlaws", "Highway to Heaven", "Freddy's Nightmares", and "Tour of Duty". Lar served as a celebrity on-air guest for the QVC channel for an impressive 19 years, presenting beauty and travel products.

Continuing to leave her mark in the entertainment industry, Lar has recently completed five film projects. Simultaneously, she shapes the next generation of actors through Actors Audition Studios. 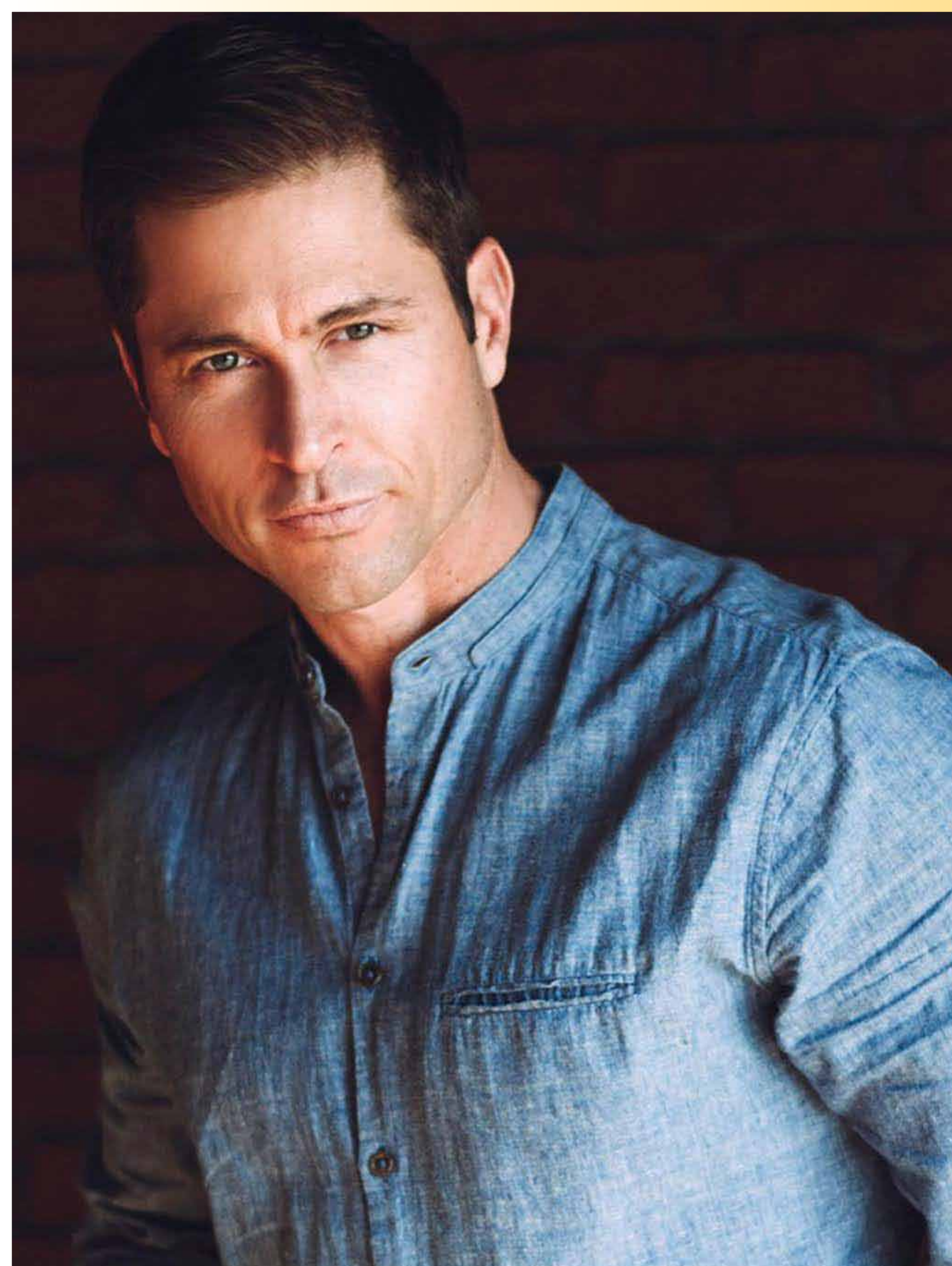

Jason Faunt was born in McHenry Illinois which is a small suburb about 50 miles northwest of Chicago. He had dreams of being a major league baseball player since he was a child but after seeing the movie risky business decided he wanted to change his focus to becoming in actor.

He promised his family he would finish college first but two weeks after graduation he packed up his pickup truck with about \$1000 to his name and moved to Los Angeles to pursue his dream...after several small rolls on soap operas Jason booked the legendary role of Wesley Collins (as well as his descendant, Alex), the Red Ranger in "Power Rangers Time Force". Since Time Force concluded, Jason has reprised his role in a number of anniversary and crossover episodes, including the 10th anniversary episode, "Forever Red" during "Power Rangers Wild Force", the 20th anniversary episode, "The Legendary Battle" during "Power Rangers Super Megaforce", and the 25th anniversary episode, "Dimensions In Danger" during "Power Rangers Super Ninja Steel".

Jason also did the motion capture work for the hit game, "Resident Evil 6" as Leon Kennedy. Jason also voiced the character 'Aaron' in the animated film, "Resident Evil: Vendetta."

Jason most recently appeared in the Tubi television series, "Under Developed" as Freckles. Jason will be starring in the upcoming film, "Legend of the White Dragon" as Conner.

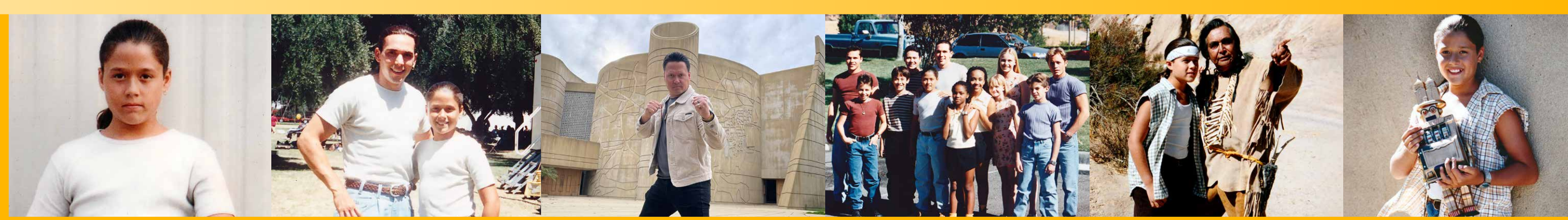

Hannah Rose Fierman (born 8 September 1987 in Trowbridge, Wiltshire) is an English-born American actress best known for her role as Lily the succubus in "V/H/S (2012) and "Siren" (2016).

Hannah began acting at the age of three for theater before showing an interest in film and television. She had since racked up a large filmography and has never stopped. She started gaining recognition in the horror genre with her performance as Lily in the horror anthology "V/H/S" for the segment "Amateur Night". On being cast, Fierman admitted that the concept confused her somewhat, "You know, somebody comes up to you and says, 'Hey, want to be a naked demon girl in my movie?' It's like, Gosh, do I? But David is such an amazing storyteller. It was so interesting the way he described it...I thought he was a brilliant director." She also found the character sympathetic, "I wanted the viewer to be on her team even after the savagery or at least be understanding of why she did it." She would reprise her role in "Siren", loosely based on the segment. Fierman continued her role in horror related projects such as "Dead by Midnight", as a headlined actress.

Hannah later guest starred in the Creepshow episode "Night of the Living Late Show" as her rendition of Countess Irina Petrovska from "Horror Express." Then she guest-starred as Fawn in the episode "Familiar".

In April 2022, Fierman wrote, directed, and starred in the music video for the song "Hair" from the band 'The Lucid.'

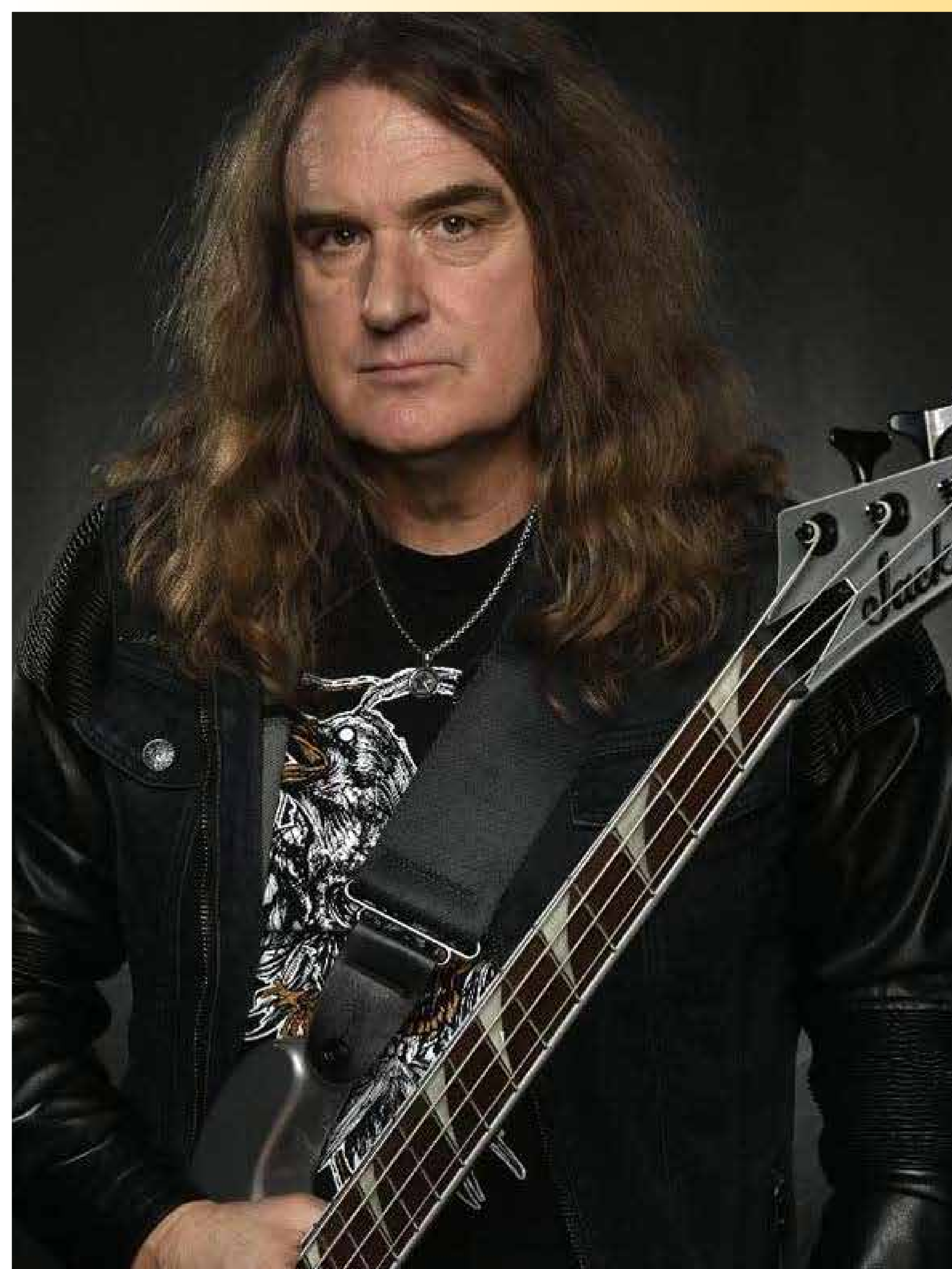

# DAVID ELLEFSON

MUSICIAN • ACTOR



David Warren Ellefson (born November 12, 1964) is an American musician, best known for his long tenure as the bassist for thrash metal band Megadeth.

Ellefson initially became an accomplished bassist and honed his songwriting skills while leading several of his own bands through the club scene of North America's Midwest region before relocating to Los Angeles. He was then the bassist of Megadeth from 1983 to 2002, and again from 2010 to 2021.

In May 2019 Ellefson along with business partner Thom Hazaert formed Ellefson Films and are produced the found footage horror film "Dwellers"; written, directed by, and starring Drew Fortier with James L. Edwards and Douglas Esper co-starring. On top of producing the project, Ellefson and Hazaert also appeared in the film as featured cameos. In November 2020 Ellefson announced that he had completed a fiction thriller novel titled "Rock Star Hitman" co-written with Drew Fortier to be released via his book imprint The Ellefson Book Co in December 2020.

Ellefson co-founded the hard rock band the Lucid in 2021 alongside vocalist Vinnie Dombroski (Sponge), guitarist Drew Fortier (formerly of Bang Tango), and drummer Mike Heller (Fear Factory, Malignancy, Raven). In addition to playing bass guitar in Megadeth and the Lucid, Ellefson had various side projects, which include Temple of Brutality, F5, Killing Machine, and Metal Allegiance.

# DREW FORTIER

MUSICIAN • ACTOR • WRITER • DIRECTOR

Drew Fortier is an award winning filmmaker, actor, author, and musician known for his work with such artists as David Ellefson (Megadeth), Bang Tango, Chuck Mosley (Faith No More), and most recently “The Lucid” which also features Sponge frontman Vinnie Dombroski, Megadeth co-founder/bassist David Ellefson, and Fear Factory drummer Mike Heller.

Fortier established himself as a multi-faceted creative force by way of directing the critically acclaimed rock documentary “Attack of Life: The Bang Tango Movie” followed by joining Bang Tango as a guitarist which led him to write 'Dark, Depressing, and Hilarious'; a sarcastic and sardonic memoir about his eclectic experiences cutting his teeth in the music business up to that point, which also included joining the solo band for now late “Faith No More” front-man Chuck Mosley.

After taking a left turn into acting, Fortier co-starred in the low budget cult horror film “Her Name Was Christa” which has been critically acclaimed as being 'the most romantic necrophilia love story ever told'. In 2021, he went on to portray a fictionalized version of himself in the critically confused but award-winning, zero budget, found footage horror film “Dwellers”, which has been described as C.H.U.D. if it were shot like “The Blair Witch Project”. Fortier will also be appearing in the upcoming horror films Trivial, and Dementophobia.

In 2021, Fortier co-wrote the fiction action thriller Rock Star Hitman with frequent collaborator David Ellefson.

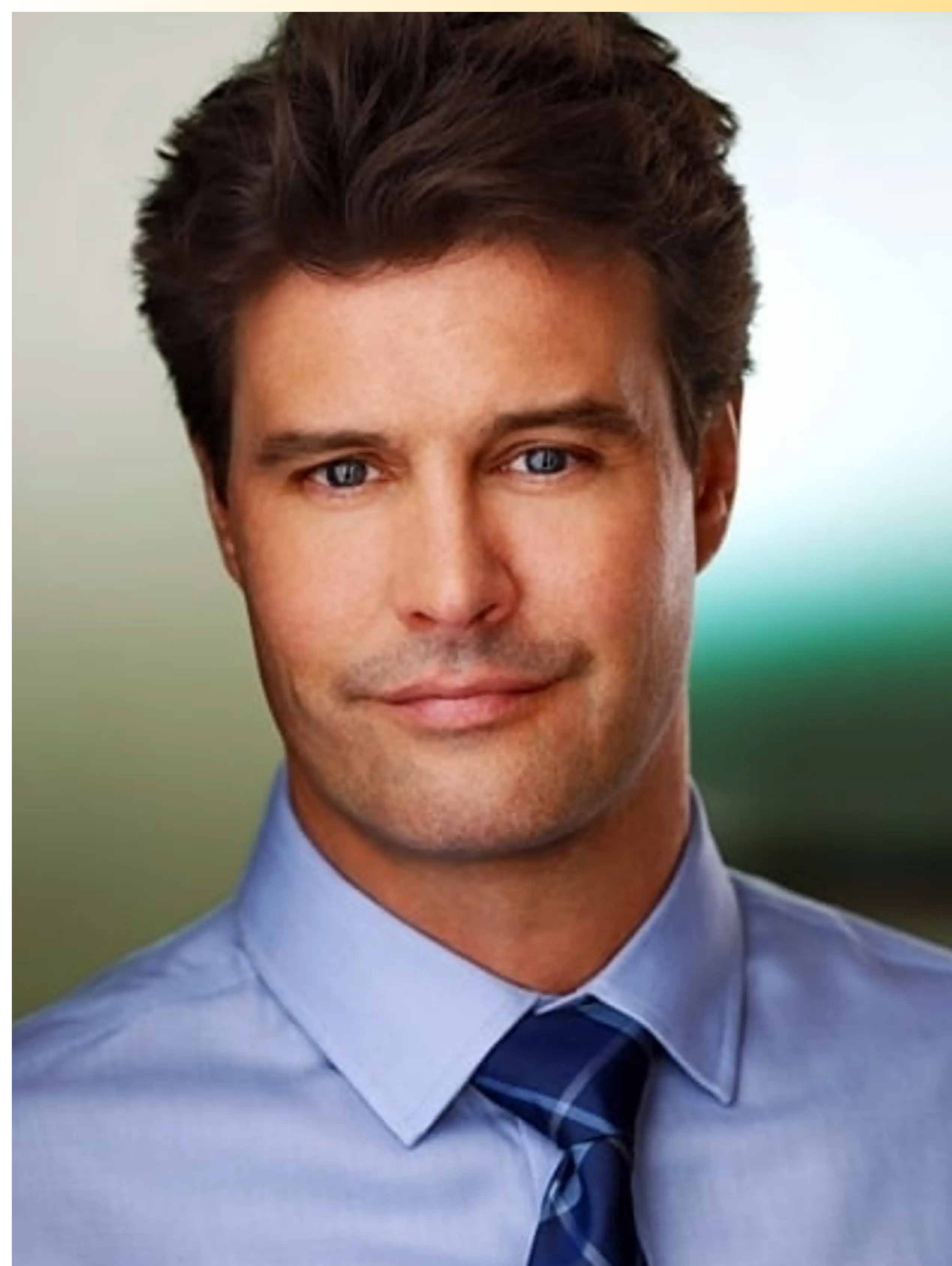

ACTOR • COMEDIAN

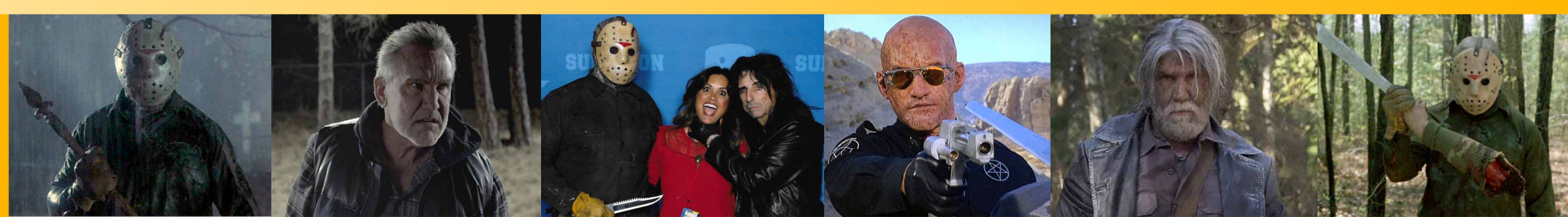
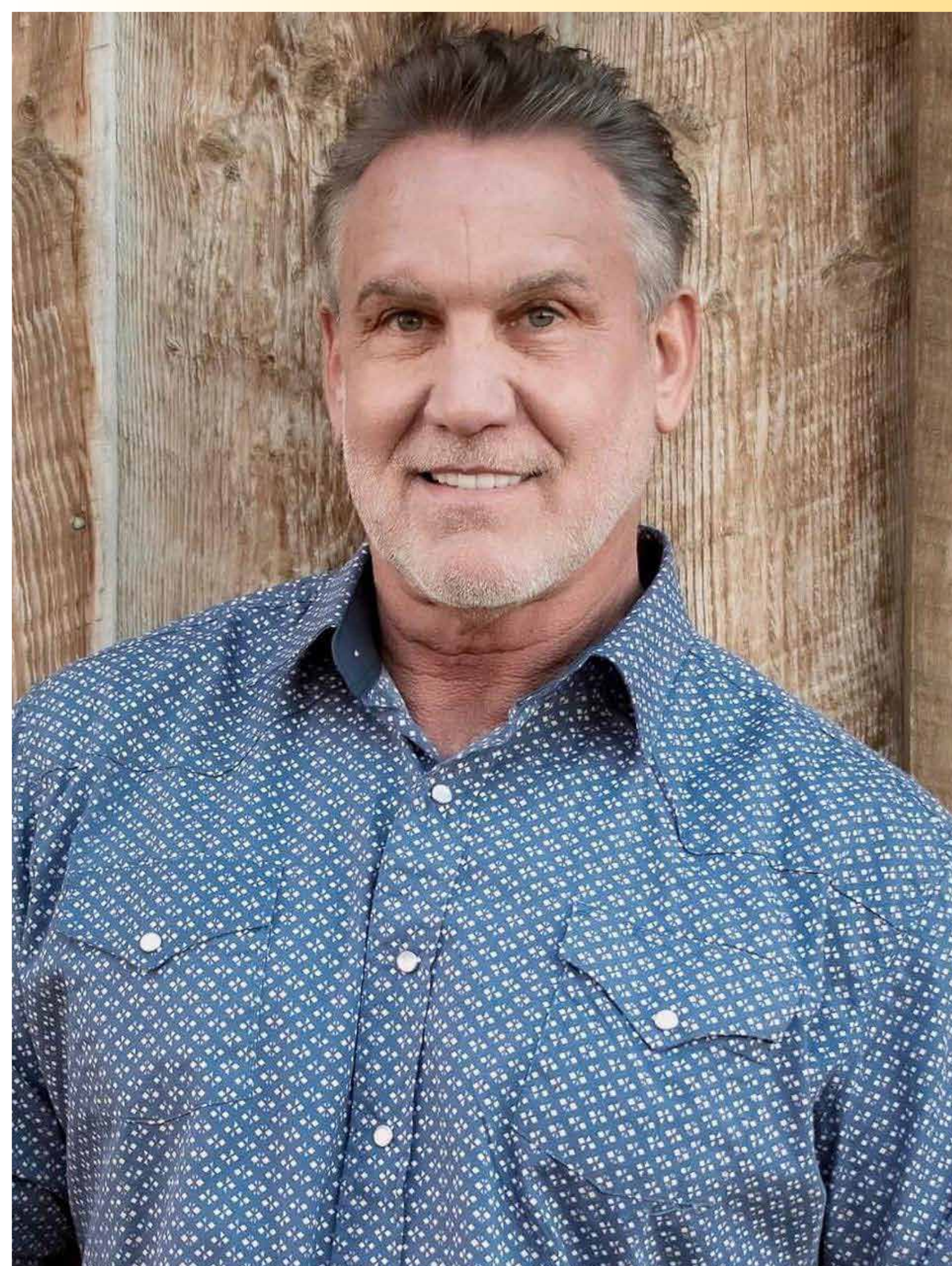

Dave Sheridan is an American actor, producer and writer. He is best known for playing Special Officer Doofy in the comedy "Scary Movie" (a spoof of deputy sheriff Dewey Riley from "Scream").

Dave began his career as an intern at "Saturday Night Live" during the 1991–1992 season. From there, he entered Chicago's famed comedy troupe, "The Second City", where he wrote, directed, and produced "Dave Sheridan's America", a multimedia stage show. He created "Buzzkill", a 1995 MTV reality series that featured three slacker buddies staging elaborate pranks and catching it all on video. Sheridan appeared in the 2002 music videos for "By the Way" (playing a crazy taxi driver) and "Universally Speaking" by Red Hot Chili Peppers. He also toured with his band that formed in 2004, Van Stone. Dave hosted a series called "Smile...You're Under Arrest!" on the Fox Reality Channel in 2008–09.

Sheridan is well known for his role in "Scary Movie" (2000) as Officer Doofy. To this day, Dave continues to wear the Officer Doofy attire and poses with fans for photos at pop culture conventions. Since then, Dave has starred in a number of films produced by the Wayans Brothers, including "Little Man", "50 Shades of Black", and both "A Haunted House" films. He also portrayed the character Doug in the 2001 film "Ghost World". Dave has also starred in many well-known comedies, including "Bubble Boy" and "Sex Drive." He is also well known for his work in the horror genre, with films such as Rob Zombie's "The Devil's Rejects", Adam Green's fourth installment of the "Hatchet" franchise, "Victor Crowley", and the 2024 Fuzz on the Lens Productions film "Stream."

C. J. Graham is an American actor who became known for playing Jason Voorhees in the sixth installment of the "Friday the 13th" franchise, "Friday the 13th Part VI: Jason Lives". He served in the U.S. Military from 1974-1978.

A 6'3" former nightclub owner, he was spotted as a potential Jason Voorhees for "Friday the 13th Part VI: Jason Lives" when he was playing Jason in a night club act, impressing the casting people who were in search of a new Jason. He played Jason in all scenes and stunts except for the Paintball scene, which they had already filmed with actor Dan Bradley, as well as the opening graveyard scene which was played by Christopher Swift. Graham reprised this role in the video for Alice Cooper's "He's Back (The Man Behind the Mask)".

C.J. also appeared in the horror film Highway to Hell as the main antagonist, a heavily made-up, silent monster called the Hell Cop. As of 2010, Graham is the VP of casino operations at Thunder Valley Casino in Lincoln, California. He has been known to speak highly of his time as Jason, even claiming that he would reprise the role in another film if asked.

Graham has appeared in two fan films revolving around Jason Voorhees, including the 2019 film, "Friday the 13th - Vengeance" as Elias Voorhees (Jason's father). C.J. also appeared as himself in the 2021 film "13 Fanboy", a story about an obsessed fan that stalks his favorite actors from the Friday the 13th films and beyond, mirroring his idol, Jason Voorhees.

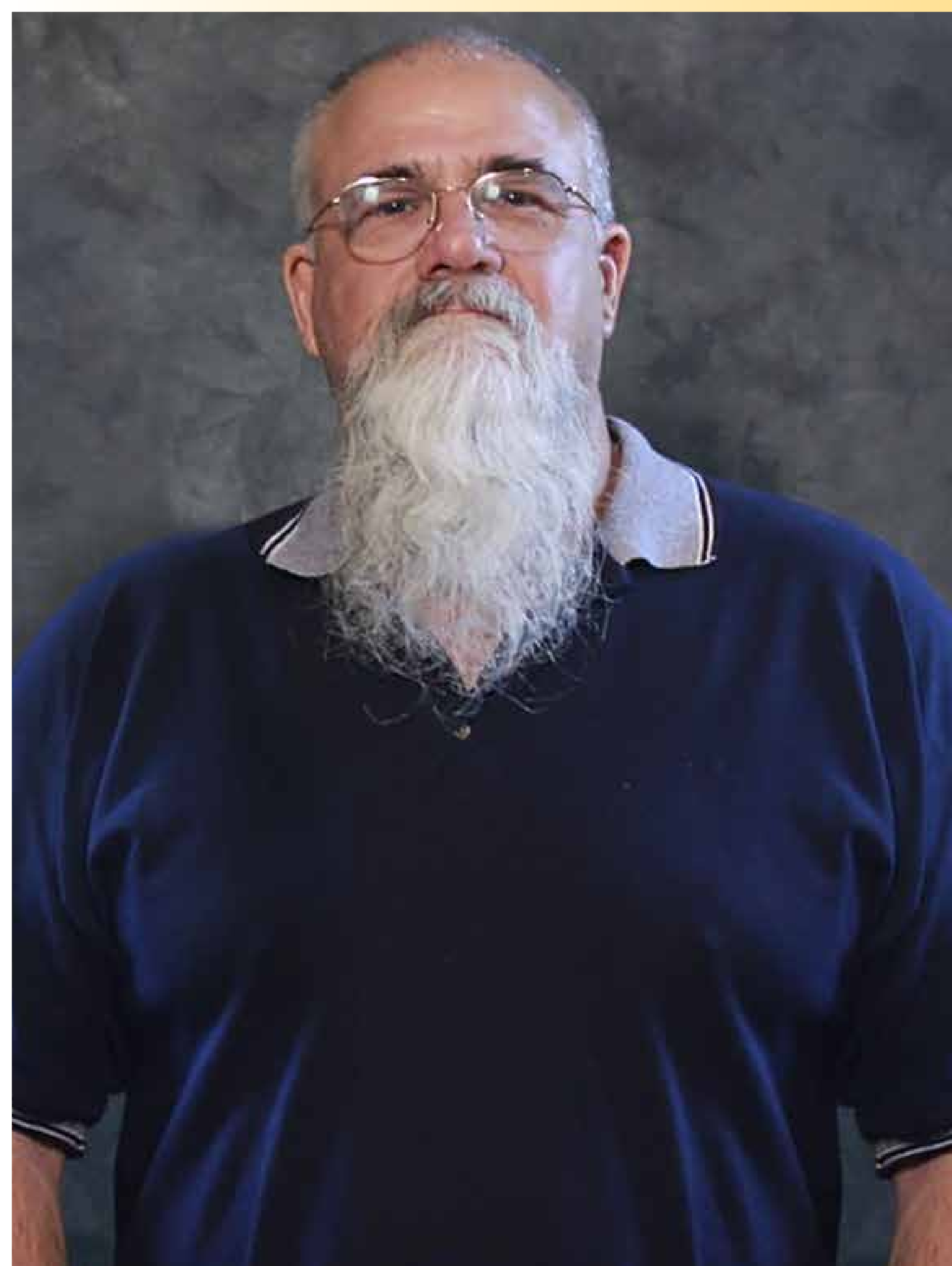

# BOB ELMORE

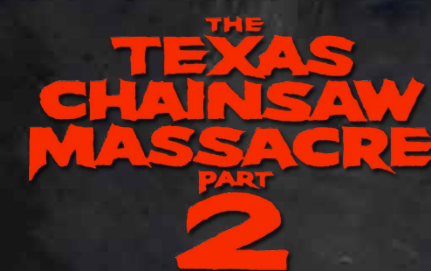
ACTOR • STUNT PERFORMER

Bob was hired, alongside Tom Morga, as Bill Johnson's stunt doubles in the role. Elmore performed many of the physical scenes for the character, including the chainsaw battle with Dennis Hopper, and the overall stunt portion of the infamous 'chainsaw love' scene. Filming was particularly grueling for Elmore, Johnson, and the rest of the cast and crew, as they had to deal with extreme temperatures while in a heavily insulated costume that only exposed the eyes and mouth. Elmore later recounted the entire experience as being incredibly taxing, both physically and mentally.

With over 30 years of experience in the film industry, Bob has also worked on numerous other horror films, including "The Monster Squad" as two of the sheriffs that get killed, one which was by Count Dracula. Outside of the horror genre, Bob also appears as the Executioner in both "Pirates of the Caribbean: The Curse of the Black Pearl", and "Pirates of the Caribbean: At World's End."

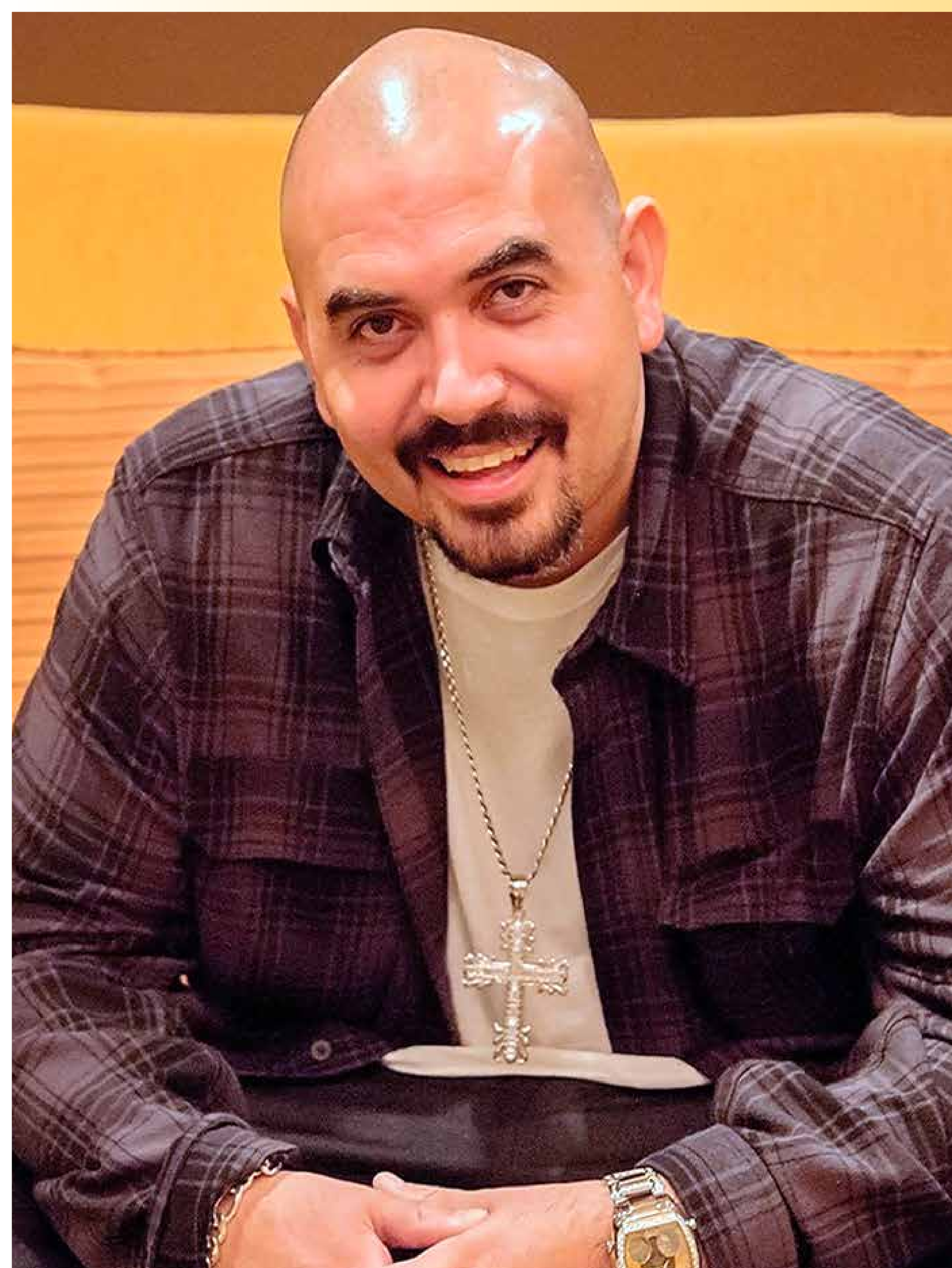
His skill and dedication have earned him a loyal following among horror fans worldwide, and he continues to inspire and entertain audiences with his performances.

As an adult, Rist has worked as a voice actor, such as in the “Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles” film series (as the voice of Michaelangelo). From 1984 to 1986, he starred in the Saturday morning cartoon Kidd Video, playing the character Whiz both in live-action music videos and animated sequences.
